



What is Purdue Air Link 2.0?

Purdue Air Link (PAL) 2.0 is the standard method for connecting to Purdue’s wireless network. PAL 2.0 does not use virtual private network (VPN) connections for authentication, so the connection is faster and more reliable.

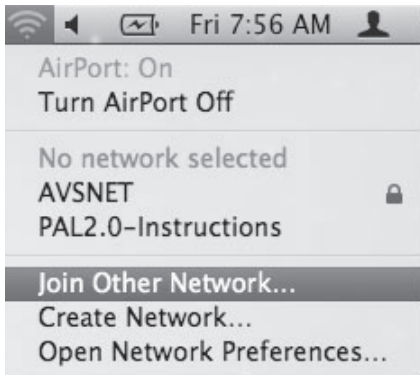
Why should I use PAL 2.0?

PAL 2.0 is a new method of connecting to and using the wireless network at Purdue’s West Lafayette campus. It is more secure, reliable, and convenient than the first version of PAL. It uses encrypted and authenticated connections, also known as Wi-Fi protected access (WPA) connections, to Purdue’s wireless access points. By using PAL 2.0, users are less likely to experience dropped connections, and they have the ability to roam to other access points without interruption.

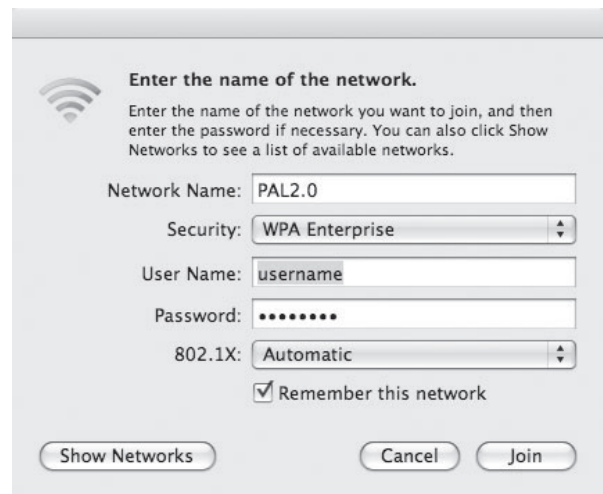
How do I connect to PAL 2.0 with Mac OS X Leopard?

1 Click the **AirPort** icon in your menu bar.

2 Select **Join Other Network** from the menu.



3 In the **Network Setup Screen**, enter the information as shown below, using your own career account login and password in the **User Name** and **Password** fields.



4 When asked to approve the confidential information in your keychain, choose **Always Allow**.
