

## Instructions for using Direct Connect VPN to Purdue Airlink (PAL) wireless network Windows 98

How do I set up my machine running Windows 98 to use a VPN connection to access the wireless network?

For a Windows 98 machine, you will first you need to set up VPN:

1. Click on "Start"
2. Go to "Settings" - "Control Panel"
3. Click on "Add/Remove Programs"
4. Click on the "Windows Setup" tab
5. If "Virtual Private Networking" does not appear in the list, click on "Communications" and then click on the "Details" button
6. Finally, click on "Virtual Private Networking"
7. Restart your machine when requested

Then you need to set up a VPN connection.

1. Click on the "My Computer" desktop icon
2. Click on the "Dial-Up Networking" folder
3. Click on "Make New Connection"
4. Name the connection (example: PAL) and click "Next"
5. When the screen requests a Host name or IP address enter: vpn1.airlink.purdue.edu
6. Click "Next" and then "Finish"
7. Right click on the above icon you have created:
  1. Select "Properties"
  2. Click on the "Server types" tab
  3. The following boxes should be checked:
    - Require encrypted password
    - Require data encryption
  4. The following boxes should be unchecked:
    - Log on to network
    - Enable software compression
    - NetBEUI
    - IPX/SPX Compatible
8. Click OK.

Now that my machine is all set up, how do I connect?

Once this connection has been established, start the VPN connection by clicking on the icon (example: PAL) which is located in the "Dial Up Networking" folder on "My Computer".
