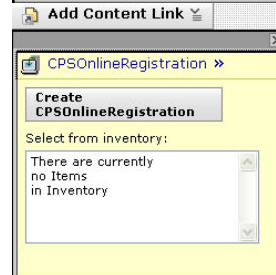
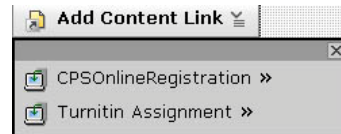
I teach a course using Blackboard and would like to use the eInstruction Classroom response system with my students. How do I allow my students to register their CPS response pads?

1. Point your web browser to the Blackboard login page:

2. Login to Blackboard. Select the course in which you will use the classroom response system.
3. Course creation procedure for CPS:

- Under the “Build Tab” click the “Add Content Link” button, which will drop down.
- Choose the “CPSOnlineRegistration” option.
- Click the “Create CPSOnlineRegistration” button.

NOTE: You should enter the last day that students will need to use their CPS pads in your class.

- Enter the name of the registration link, i.e. “Register your CPS pad,” then click the “Register Class” button.
- Choose the campus for this course (Purdue University – West Lafayette)
- Enter an end date for your class, such as a date after the semester’s final exam week.
- Instructor setup code field will already be populated with the correct information of “purduniv1107”
- Create a CPS-WebCT connection username and password. Please note, this is also referred to as your CPS Online user name and password.
- Click “Register Class,” then click the “Finish Registration” button on the next page.

4. The link for your students to register has now been created, and you may direct them to login to Blackboard and register their CPS pads.
