*RESOLUTION**

Whereas the Board of Trustees at its regular meeting on March 21, 1973, adopted a resolution wherein it would give consideration to formal proposals for academic autonomy with respect to undergraduate matters provided they are submitted through appropriate channels and provided they are consistent with the policies and procedures set forth in Attachment A[†] to that resolution; and

Whereas the Calumet Campus has submitted a proposal for academic autonomy through appropriate channels for consideration by the board:

It is resolved, That this Board of Trustees extends to the Calumet Campus faculty those general and specific powers and responsibilities as set forth in Section A 4.00 and A 4.05 of the University Code with respect to undergraduate matters at the Calumet Campus, provided that said campus shall not implement changes which might conflict with Attachment A of the board's resolution of March 21, 1973, unless or until appropriate coordinating mechanisms are in place which will assure that such conditions are met. Such additional mechanisms needed are to be created by the president of the University after consultation with the appropriate administrative officers of the several campuses of the University.

It is further resolved, That the Board of Trustees approves the articles for faculty governance for the Calumet Campus as set forth in Attachment A[‡] which is hereby made a part of this resolution.

It is further resolved, That the Board of Trustees approves the reorganization of the Calumet Campus academic structure with the schools and departments as set forth in Attachment B* which is hereby made a part of this resolution.

It is further resolved, That the Board of Trustees approves the continuation of the undergraduate degrees and programs currently authorized for the Calumet Campus as set forth in Attachment C† which is hereby made a part of this resolution.

Be it further resolved, That the Board of Trustees approves the continuation of the graduate degrees and programs at the Calumet Campus under the direction of the Graduate Council and those schools and departments of the University which are academically responsible for the degrees and programs as set forth in Attachment D‡ which is hereby made a part of this resolution.
